The Maritime Mobile Service Network operates 365 days a year on a frequency of 14.300 MHz from 1200-2200 hours during daylight savings and from 1200-2100 hours during Eastern Standard Time. Most amateurs are aware that the net's primary purpose is to assist maritime vessels in times of emergencies and with routine traffic.

In the wake of the devastating damage caused by the recent hurricanes, The Maritime Mobile Service Net is listening for any traffic from the affected areas. We are committed to assisting in any way possible with health and welfare traffic from the affected area.

Net members are being instructed that after checking for maritime mobiles that they immediately check for stations that might need assistance in those areas that might have contact traffic or need assistance during this crisis.

Please direct any stations within the effected area to our net and we will render any assistance that we can provide. It should be noted that 14.300 MHz is the designated emergency center of activity frequencies adopted by the IARU Region 1 General Conference in 2005.
